Statement on Registering Handicapped Dogs

MBDCA is an organization primarily for mixed breed dogs and their owners. Nonetheless, MBDCA believes that all dogs and their owners deserve an opportunity to compete in dog sports. Accordingly, MBDCA registers handicapped dogs, including purebreds. Persons wishing to register a handicapped dog under this provision need to complete this certificate and return it with the regular registration paperwork to the Membership Secretary.
